A NOTE TO CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS:

On October 3, 2016, the transition period from the 2010 Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code to the 2015 International Building Code in New York State will end. As a result, the revised training requirements will take full effect, and the Local Government Training Program’s courses can no longer be used toward approved in-service training. These courses may, however, be used as a Professional Development Electives.

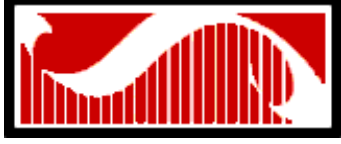
